



Application to the CSIP Dataset and License Agreement

Introduction

The main objective of the CSIP database was to gather images from a representative group of participants, acquired over cross-sensor setups and varying acquisition scenarios, thus mimicking the conditions faced on mobile application scenarios. Along with the data acquired with different mobile devices, an iris segmentation mask is also provided, allowing assessing the performance of both iris and periocular segmentation and recognition algorithms on mobile environments.

To receive access to the CSIP, requests should be submitted to one of the researchers on behalf of the academic or commercial institution that wishes to access the database. Researcher must print, fill out and manually sign this document and agree to the terms described below. The signed document should be digitized and *sent through email* to either gmelfe@ubi.pt (Gil Santos, Dept. of Computer Science, IT - Instituto de Telecomunicações) or fiadeiro@ubi.pt (Paulo T. Fiadeiro, Dept. of Physics, Remote Sensing Unit - Optics, Optometry and Vision Sciences Group, University of Beira Interior, Covilhã, Portugal).

The University of Beira Interior owns copyright of the images and serves as the unique source for the CSIP dataset distributed exclusively for research / educational purposes.

Terms

In this agreement,

1. '*Primary Researcher*' refers to the investigator who serves as main point of contact for all communications involving this agreement. The *Primary Researcher* assumes all responsibility for the compliance with all terms of this agreement, by him / her and '*Other Investigators*' of the receiving organization.
2. '*Other Investigators*' refers to individuals other than the *Primary Researcher*, who will have access to the CSIP dataset.
3. '*Receiving Organization*' refers to the organization / university / establishment which employs the *Primary Researcher*.

10. This agreement will come into force on the date that approval is given for access to the CSIP dataset and remain in force as long as the *Receiving institution* holds any copy of the dataset, even if not in use.

If there are any changes to the personnel or organization detailed on this application form, it is the responsibility of the *Primary Researcher* to report such alterations and seek for agreement. Where there is a change to the employer organization of the *Primary Researcher* will involve a fresh application being made.
